# **English-Writing:**



# **PSHE**

In this Puzzle, the children explore setting realistic goals and how they can achieve them. This will link to our learning goal of resilience.

### **Computing**

In computing we will be learning all about robots and algorithms. We will be creating and debugging programs, and using logical reasoning to make predictions.

### Science

As Scientists we will be exploring 'Changing Seasons'. We will be learning about why seasons occur and how the length of daylight changes throughout the year. We will be going on a seasonal walk, making observations of seasonal changes and working scientifically to ask and answer questions. We will explore how we can measure weather and set up our investigations to measure

#### RE

As theologians we will be exploring the question: Who is Jewish and what do they believe? The children will be exploring how people of the Jewish faith remember God in different ways

# <u>Music</u>

Our unit this half term is: 'Wanna Play in a Band'. This is a rock song especially written for children. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, we will listen and appraise classic Rock songs such as 'We Will Rock You' and 'Johnny B. Goode'. As we develop our confidence in performing with our voices, we will begin to use the glockenspiels to add our own compositions.

### Art

This project teaches children about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. They also explore various artistic methods, including drawing, printmaking and 3-D forms, using paper and clay. Children will complete this unit by sculpting their own clay flower inspired by the work of Yayoi Kusama.
